NOTE

Paragraphs 10 and 15 of Schedule 24 of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1972 provides for the recovery of compensation overpaid and lay down penalties for any person found guilty of giving false information in claiming compensation.

SCHEDULE OF ACCOMMODATION WORKS

The Secretary of State for Scotland shall, at his own expense carry out the following accommodation works.

Plot 51

- a. Work at access roads (2 No) covered by Roads (Scotland) Act 1984, Section 12(1) Order.
- b. Reinstate disturbed ground to suit existing.
- c. Remove existing post and wire fencing and replace with woven wire fence 1150mm high with wooden posts, 2 strands of galvanised barbed wire and 2 strands of galvanised plain wire at land acquisition boundary.
- d. Remove and re-erect in new position 3 No PRIVATE signs.

Plot 53

- a. Remove existing deer fencing and replace with woven wire fence 1150mm high with wooden posts, 2 strands of galvanised barbed wire and 2 strands of galvanised plain wire at land acquisition boundary.
- b. Remove and re-erect in new position 2 No field gates.
- c. Remove and resite in new position cattle trough with water supply.
- d. Regrade field locally to suit new gate position.
- e. Reinstate disturbed ground to suit existing.

Plot 67

- a. Remove existing post and wire fencing and replace with woven wire fence 1150mm high with wooden posts, 2 strands of galvanised barbed wire and 2 strands of galvanised plain wire at land acquisition boundary.
- b. Reinstate disturbed ground to suit existing.


Plot 68

- a. Same as 67.
- b. Same as 67.

Plot 52

- a. Provision of temporary post and wire fence on boundary of plot for duration of outfall construction.
- b. Regrade approximately 360 square metres of field to provide adequate cover to outfall pipe adjacent to Green Burn.
- c. Collect existing flow to Rowett Burn in proposed outfall pipe.
- d. Reinstate disturbed ground to suit existing.



Plot 79

- a. Construct 6 metre wide road leading to underpass on south side of (A96) (approx 130 lin metres) including verges, side slopes and associated drainage and visibility splays to Forvit Brae.
- b. Erect woven wire fence 1150mm high with wooden posts, 2 strands of galvanised barbed wire and 2 strands of galvanised plain wire at top of cutting slopes to accommodation road.
- c. Instal cattle grid with by-pass road and gate on accommodation road.
- d. Supply and erect 2 wooden field gates.
- e. Top soil and seed verges and side slopes to accommodation road.
- f. Reinstate disturbed ground to suit existing.

Plot 80

- a. Construct 5.5 metre wide road leading to underpass on north side of A96 (approx 130 lin metres), including verges, side slopes and associated drainage.
- b. Erect woven wire fence 1150mm high with wooden posts, 2 strands of galvanised barbed wire and 2 strands of galvanised plain wire at top of cutting slopes to accommodation road.
- c. Instal cattle grid with by-pass road and gate on accommodation road.
- d. Supply and erect wooden field gate.
- e. Top soil and seed verges and side slopes to accommodation road.
- f. Construct drainage outfall from underpass to Rowett burn (approx 40 lin metres).
- g. Regrade field locally to provide adequate cover to outfall.
- h. Remove existing post and wire fence and replace with woven wire fence 1150mm high with wooden posts, 2 strands of galvanised plain wire over regraded field at Rowett burn.
- i. Reinstate disturbed ground to suit existing.
